Applicants' information is collected to execute and complete the application process.

The information content of the register that will be collected and archived

Personal data:

Name, e-mail, phone number, place of residence, website address.

Additional data collected: curriculum vitae, professional artistic qualifications, memberships in artists' associations, exhibitions ja references.

The register protection and security measures

Data is stored and transmitted through a secure connection (https). The customer data is password protected and all the policies employ other legitimate information security regulations. Biennale staff processes information safely under general and ethical information privacy policy.

The disclosure of the personal data

The personal data is processed and handled only by the biennale staff. Information will not be given outside of European Union. Personal data will not be shared with third parties without permission.

Giving access to personal data, processing and prohibition

By sending the open call application form the person accepts their personal data (as stated above) to be filed and archived. The customer has a right to erase his/her information. Requests to be asked to be removed from the register are asked to be submitted in written form to the responsible manager, in order the request to be verified.
